PCB Land Pattern



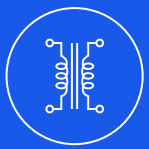

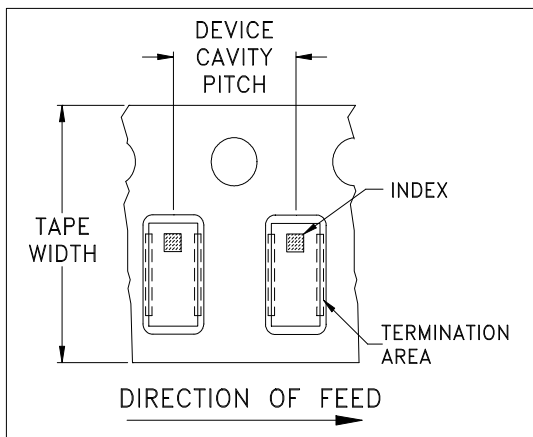

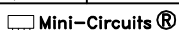
