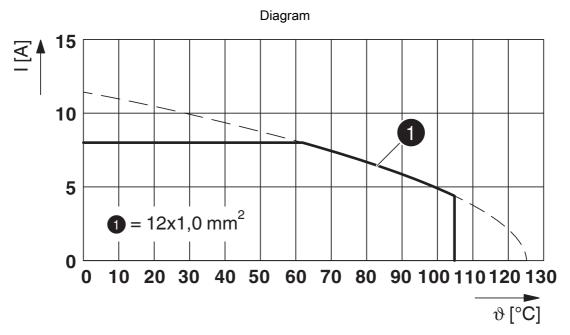

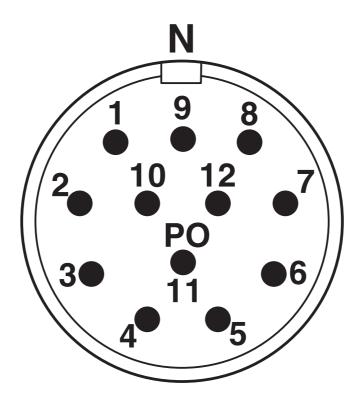
I = current strength,  $\vartheta$  = ambient temperature, 12x 8 A
