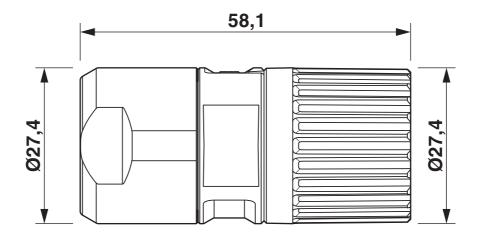

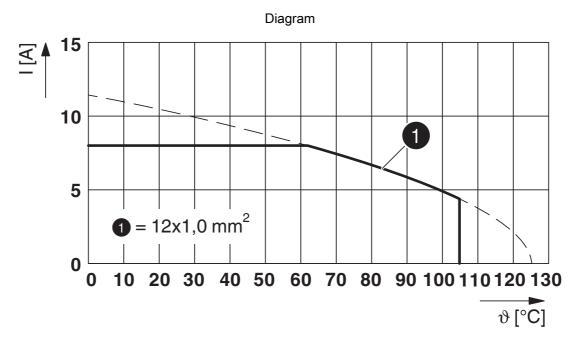

Dimensional drawing, housing



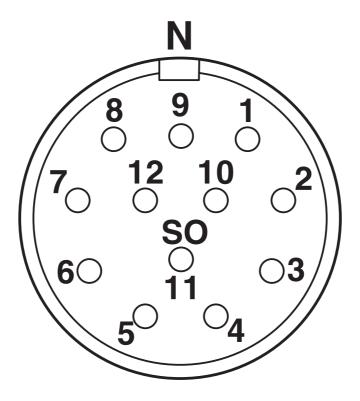
