

FRED Ultrafast Soft Recovery Diode, 60A/1200V

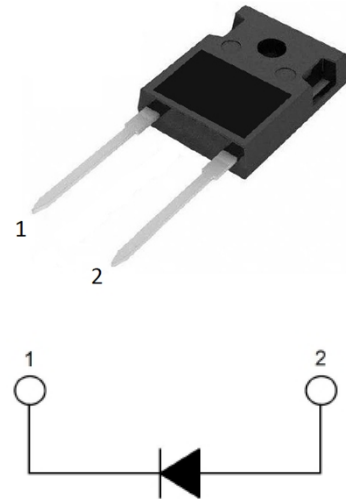
Description

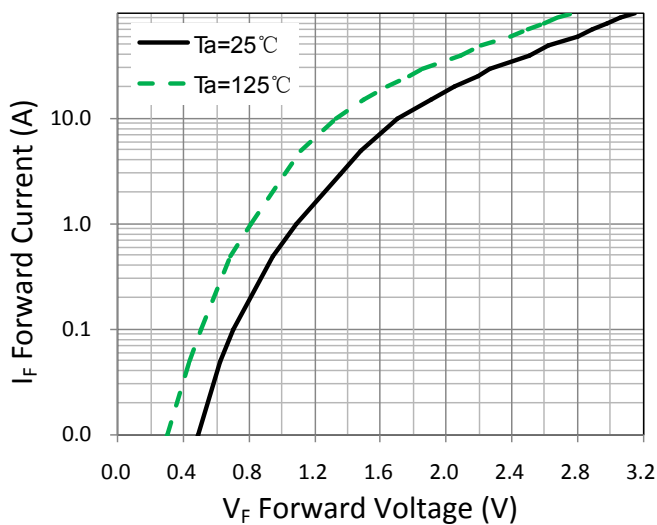


Figure 1. Forward Characteristic(typ.)

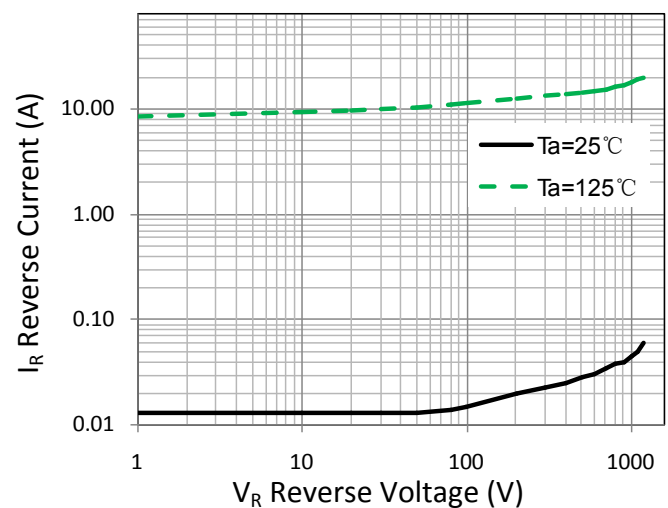
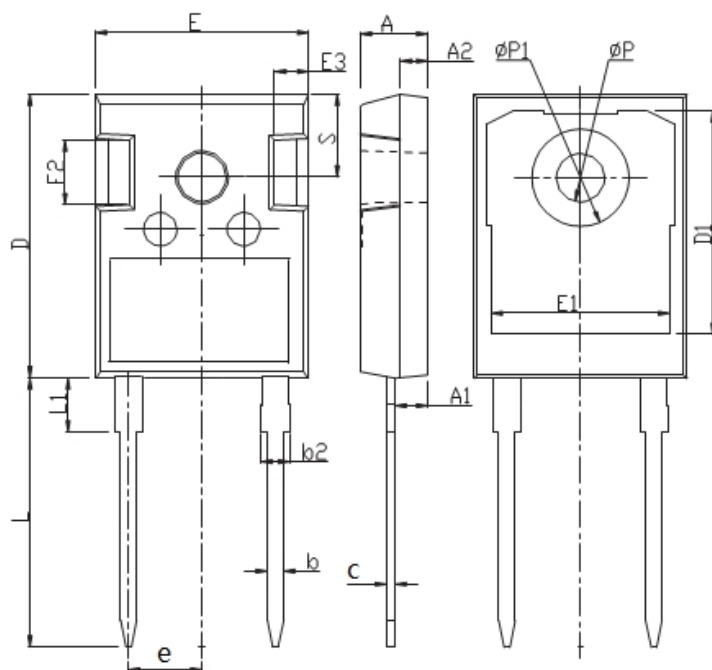


Figure 2. Reverse Characteristic (typ.)
