


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

DESCRIPTION/APPLICATIONS

State of the art hyperfast recovery rectifiers designed with optimized performance of forward voltage drop, hyperfast recovery time, and soft recovery.

The planar structure and the platinum doped life time control guarantee the best overall performance, ruggedness and reliability characteristics.

These devices are intended for use in PFC boost stage in the AC-DC section of SMPS, inverters or as freewheeling diodes.

Their extremely optimized stored charge and low recovery current minimize the switching losses and reduce over dissipation in the switching element and snubbers.

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


Fig. 1 - Typical Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics




Fig. 2 - Typical Values of Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage




Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage




Fig. 4 - Maximum Thermal Impedance Z_{thJC} Characteristics

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


Fig. 5 - Maximum Thermal Impedance ZthJC Characteristics (FULL-PAK)




Fig. 6 - Maximum Allowable Case Temperature vs. Average Forward Current




Fig. 7 - Maximum Allowable Case Temperature vs. Average Forward Current (FULL-PAK)




Fig. 8 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics

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


Fig. 9 - Typical Reverse Recovery Time vs. dl_F/dt




Fig. 10 - Typical Stored Charge vs. dl_F/dt





Fig. 11 - Reverse Recovery Parameter Test Circuit

- (4) \mathbf{Q}_{rr} area under curve defined by \mathbf{t}_{rr} and \mathbf{I}_{RRM}

$$Q_{rr} = \frac{t_{rr} \times I_{RRM}}{2}$$

Fig. 12 - Reverse Recovery Waveform and Definitions


